



# BAGGAGE ALLOWANCES AND COSTS

CASH IS NOT ACCEPTED AT THE AIRPORT TO PAY FOR EXCESS BAGGAGE.  
A PREPAID ACTIVATED CREDIT CARD OR A DEBIT CARD IS ACCEPTED

## JAMAICA, BARBADOS and ST. LUCIA VIA AIR CANADA

### BICYCLES:

A fixed handling charge of \$59.00 CAD/USD one way applies.

### CARRY ON BAGGAGE:

Not to exceed 9" (23cm) by 15.5" (40cm) by 21.5" (55cm) and 22lbs. (10kgs) in weight.

### BAGGAGE EMBARGO APPLIES TO KINGSTON

**JAMAICA ONLY:** A Baggage Embargo restricting checked baggage to ONE PIECE per person – NO EXCEPTIONS, for travel dates between: September 1 and December 15, 2024. Please do not confuse this time period and Baggage Embargo for Kingston Jamaica only with other baggage guidelines on this page. It supersedes all other guidelines prior to this time period.

### BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:

One (1) bag with the sum of the total dimensions not to exceed 62" (158cm) each and not weighing more than 50lbs. (23kgs). If allowable bag is oversized a charge of \$100.00 CAD will be applied. If allowable bag is overweight a charge of \$100.00 CAD will be applied. If bag is both overweight and oversized, the fee is charged only once. A second bag is permitted for a fee of \$50.00 CAD per direction (within acceptable baggage limits). NOTE: Embargo periods will apply.

### EXCESS BAGGAGE RATE:

For each excess bag a charge of \$225.00 CAD will be applied. Please note **NO EXCESS** baggage or oversize items will be accepted between September 30th and January 1st.

### ABSOLUTELY NOT ALLOWED:

Any bag weighing over 70lbs. (32kgs) will not be accepted. Passengers can re-pack or send as cargo. Bags that exceed aircraft size limitation must go as cargo (check with airline ahead of time).

## MEXICO VIA AIR CANADA

### BICYCLES:

A fixed handling charge of \$59.00 CAD/USD one way applies.

### CARRY ON BAGGAGE:

Not to exceed 9" (23cm) by 15.5" (40cm) by 21.5" (55cm) and 22lbs. (10kgs) in weight.

### BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:

One (1) bag with the sum of the total dimensions not to exceed 62" (158cm) each and not weighing more than 50lbs. (23kgs). If allowable bag is oversized a charge of \$100.00 CAD will be applied. If allowable bag is overweight a charge of \$100.00 CAD will be applied. If bag is both overweight and oversized, the fee is charged only once. A second bag is permitted for a fee of \$50.00 CAD per direction (within acceptable baggage limits)

### EXCESS BAGGAGE RATE:

For each excess bag a charge of \$225.00 CAD will be applied. Please note **NO EXCESS** baggage or oversize items will be accepted between September 14th and January 14th.

### ABSOLUTELY NOT ALLOWED:

Any bag weighing over 70lbs. (32kgs) will not be accepted. Passenger can re-pack or send as cargo. Bags that exceed aircraft size limitation must go as cargo (check with airline ahead of time).

## MEXICO VIA AEROMEXICO

### CARRY ON BAGGAGE:

Not to exceed 9" (23cm) by 14" (36cm) by 22" (56cm) and 22lbs. (10kgs) in weight.

### BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:

One (1) bag with the sum of the total dimensions not to exceed 62" (158cm) each and not weighing more than 50lbs. (23kgs). A second bag is permitted for a fee of \$50.00 CAD from Toronto to Mexico City (within acceptable baggage limits). If allowable bag is oversized a charge of \$150.00 USD will be applied. If allowable bag is overweight a charge of \$150.00 USD will be applied.

### ABSOLUTELY NOT ALLOWED:

Any bag weighing over 70lbs (32kgs) will not be accepted. Passengers can re-pack (check with airline).

## JAMAICA, TRINIDAD & TOBAGO and ECC VIA CARIBBEAN AIRLINES

### CARRY ON BAGGAGE:

Not to exceed 22lbs. (10kgs) in weight, with a maximum dimension of 45" (h + l + w). Must be able to fit under the seat or in overhead compartment.

### NO BOXES PERMITTED DURING EMBARGO DATES – DEC 1st - Dec 31st

### BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:

One (1) bag with the sum of the total dimensions not to exceed 62" (158cm) each and not weighing more than 50lbs. (23kgs). If allowable bag is between 51-70lbs. a charge of \$75.00 USD/\$90.00 CAD will be applied. A second bag is permitted for a fee of 40.00USD/\$55.00 CAD per direction (within acceptable baggage limits). **NO BAGGAGE OVER 70lbs. OR EXCEEDING 62" WILL BE ACCEPTED** Televisions up to 32 inches not exceeding weight of 23kg / 50lb and linear dimensions 157 cm / 62in may form part of your free checked baggage allowance.

### EXCESS BAGGAGE RATE:

Third bag within the acceptable size & weight a charge of \$150.00 USD / \$200.00 CAD will be applied. Third bag that is 51-70lbs. a charge of \$175.00 USD / \$210.00 CAD will be applied. Excess baggage is taken on a stand-by basis. **NO EXCESS** baggage or oversize items will be accepted between December 1st and December 31st.

### ABSOLUTELY NOT ALLOWED:

Any bag weighing over 70lbs. (32kgs) will not be accepted (check with airline).

**Note:** Common items that **CANNOT** be checked-in or carried on an aircraft include: cooking oil, bleach, propane cylinders, laundry detergent, dishwashing liquid, paint, paint thinner, drain cleaners, inflated balls, poisons.

The airlines will refuse to carry any gasoline motor such as a chain saw, even if the gas tank has been drained. The airlines will also refuse battery operated items such as car boosters or hover boards. Travelers are not allowed to pack weapons, tools, scissors or toy guns in carry-on luggage and cannot travel with any possible materials that are oxidizing, toxic, radioactive, infectious, corrosive or magnetized. **NO** plants, flowers, seeds of any kind.

The transportation of Lithium batteries varies from airline to airline, workers are advised to check the airlines 'Restricted Items' list before attempting to transport batteries including, (spare/loose) lithium metal or lithium-ion cells or batteries, for portable electronic devices.
